SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Korean International School (KIS) is an international community of learners. Established in 1994, KIS strives to create an environment that fosters an enthusiasm for learning. As a non-profit co-educational organisation, KIS aims to provide quality education to children of all nationalities, aged from 4 to 18. The reception, primary and secondary students at KIS follow the National Curriculum of the UK. In addition to the robust and comprehensive UK curriculum, specialist subjects are offered such as Foreign Languages, STEM and Creative Arts.

CURRICULUM & ACCREDITATION

Cambridge IGSCE - Years 10 & 11

- Over the course of these two years, students are prepared for the International/General Certificate of Secondary Education (I/GCSE) in eight subjects. The Examination Boards in the UK determine the syllabus for each subject and set and mark the public examination papers.
- Students must study **English Language and Literature, Mathematics, and a language (Chinese or Spanish)**. They can then select an additional four to six subjects, which must include **one science** and **one humanities**, to ensure sufficient breadth of study.
- In response to the interest and ability of our students in the sciences, KIS offers the single award sciences, allowing students to choose, one, two or all three of the science disciplines.

CURRICULUM & ACCREDITATION

Cambridge Advanced Level - Years 12 & 13

- In Years 12 & 13, the students follow the Cambridge Assessment International Education or AQA AS and A2 Level Courses. These are studied in two parts. In Year 12, students complete up to four subjects at the Cambridge International AS Level.
- In the following year, students in Year 13 select three/four of these subjects to complete the Cambridge International A2 Level.
